Improve the project effectiveness by discovering collaborators in key overseas regions for efficient operations in new and existing areas of international exchange

- Receive monthly reports on the status of cooperation regions and conduct surveys on project demands
- Build and maintain a network with institutions and agencies in operating regions and discuss with them about opportunities to cooperate
- Engage in promotional activities to introduce Jeonbuk overseas

Promotion of the Korean Language Overseas Contribute to attracting international students and vitalize Korean language education overseas for the future by creating Jeonbuk's unique educational environment to learn Korean

- 4 issues a year(quarterly publication)



Support for Foreign Communities in Jeonbuk

Support foreign communities (groups) in the province to improve their quality of life and encourage their social participation

- Support festivals, sports events, volunteer activities, and others activities for foreign communities





Support for the Social Integration of Foreigners Living in Jeonbuk

Provide foreigners residing in the province with positive images of Jeonbuk and offer them programs to enhance their social adaptability to improve their living conditions

- Provide Korean language classes for foreigners
- Run foreign representative and volunteer groups
 - Events for encouraging unity among foreign workers
- Provide visiting counseling services
